Matt Dees, Winemaker Notes:

An exciting new adventure for The Hilt. A true cool climate syrah...in this case actually pushing close to cold climate. Juicy boysenberry. Violet hard candies, lavender and the smell of the stones at Bentrack. Dust and green peppercorn. Silky, sappy and then savory. Blackberry, pepper bacon, Kalamata olive and rosewater. Stays focused and tense throughout with gently gripping tannic structure from the stem inclusion. These chalky tannins linger on the finish, but eventually lose the race to bright and vibrant red fruit that isn't even close to stopping nor slowing down. This towering and unique wine finally had the intrigue and quality to demand an Estate designation. The absolute favorite of our winemaking team. Show stopper.
